Article IX. Referendum to the Entire Membership

Section 1. Referendum

The Board of Governors may order any question, whether or not action thereon has been taken at the annual meeting, referred to a vote of the entire membership of the State Bar. Those present at the annual meeting may, by a two-thirds vote, direct the Board of Governors to take a referendum upon any matter presented or acted upon at such meeting. Whenever the Board of Governors is directed to take a referendum or whenever the board directs any question referred to a vote of the entire membership of the State Bar, the secretary shall prepare a questionnaire containing the matters upon which such vote is to be taken, and such questionnaire shall be submitted by the secretary to each member in such form that each member can vote thereon and return the same to the secretary.
